Subject: Annual Meeting of Culture of Peace Corporation

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Dear Culture of Peace Corporation Board,

Happy New Year. This is the first round of our annual meeting. For reference, I attach the conclusions of last year's annual meeting. According to our bylaws, each of you are expected to respond to this email to all of us within two weeks.

Here is the draft agenda. The only votes required are for membership in the Board of Directors (see next item). Please indicate in your return email to all of us if you wish to place any other questions on the agenda, in which case I will include them in a revised agenda to be sent at the end of the first round in two weeks.

ITEM 1. Board of Directors Membership

Three Board members are up for re-election for the next four years: Joe Yannielli, Jo Lofgren and Marcos Estrada. I hope that all three of you will agree to stand for re-election and that all of you will vote for them to continue to serve as directors.

Lillian Solheim has submitted her resignation from the Board. In her place, I suggest that you vote for Roberto Emmanuele Mercadillo. Roberto is a young (~35) neurophysiologist from Mexico City and Queretaro, Mexico, who is deeply committed to the culture of peace, and has shown his commitment by translating my books into Spanish (see below). If you wish to nominate another new member of the Board, please indicate in your return mail, along with the person's qualifications. At the present time, there are nine Board members, and the by-laws allow for ten.

ITEM 2. Responsibilities and addresses of Board Members.

New version proposed:

MISSION

The mission of the Corporation is to promote a transition from the culture of war to a culture of peace by: - maintaining the Culture of Peace Network as an internet source of information about the Global Movement for a Culture of Peace, as well as maintaining other related websites belonging to the Corporation; - promoting the development of local Culture of Peace councils or commissions;

- and managing the publications and updating and corresponding with the archives of David Adams at Olin Library, Wesleyan University.

ITEM 6 - Financial report

The financial report for the Corporation for 2014 is attached. As you can see, the situation is remarkably stable.

ITEM 7 – Access to websites and domain information

All of our websites are registered in the name of the Culture of Peace Corporation.

The website culture-of-peace.info is registered with Network Solutions by way of the internet provider XO web hosting.

So far, it seems that Herder has made the book available in Mexico but not in Europe. Since Herder has a major office in Barcelona, I will ask them to make it available from there as well.

Meanwhile I have sent you the draft of a new book which draws from CPNN and my blog. I haven't decided whether to seek a commercial publisher or just to put it on the internet. What do you think?

Oliver makes the good suggestion that in order to have more articles contributed by CPNN reporters perhaps we should have an outreach campaign to have more of them? I will appreciate your suggestions on how to do this.

He thinks that some of the students he works with may want to write articles and could use that as a school project as well and he wonders about the quality of the writing. This is a good idea and, in my opinion, we should not worry too much about quality of the writing. If there are grammatical errors that make an article unclear, I usually make a correction, but if the meaning is clear it is not necessary. I think it is better if there is a wide variety of styles of CPNN articles, which is more popular instead of professional journalism. If you know anyone who is interested in writing, please have them consult the CPNN rules at http://cpnn-world.org/write/rules.html

Meg also hopes to recruits more reporters during the trainings she does this year. She also hopes to have some time for web design and would like to look into improving CPNN.

Joe Yannielli has suggested to me privately, and I agree, that I should transfer CPNN from the present programming which I did in PERL and PHP almost a decade ago to a new programming system based on the Wordpress system but keeping the present format and structure. The old system would be difficult for someone other than me to manage, whereas Wordpress should be much easier to manage. I plan to make the transfer later this spring since it will take considerable time.

Joe also says the following regarding CPNN, "it occurred to me that one way to promote the site would be to select popular or interesting articles from its 14+ years of archives.
