Thank you for the honor of asking me to review the DeRivera handbook, but I must decline for the following reasons.

I was asked to be one of the contributors to the volume when it was first formulated, but did not agree at the time because I am fundamentally in disagreement with some of its main premises and its way of characterizing the culture of peace. In fact, there was a considerable polemic at that time which involved many of the invited contributors, and I am not the only person who declined to participate as a result.

Therefore I cannot write a fair appraisal of the book.

Instead, I will be publishing three books this spring that take a very different approach to the culture of peace, and which will stand in opposition to at least some of the premises of the DeRivera handbook. They are:

The History of the Culture of War World Peace through the Town Hall: A strategy for the global movement for a culture of peace I Have Seen the Promised Land: A utopian novel.
